Topics include:

General duty clause, intro to OSHA & ADOSH compliance inspections, general job site safety & health issues and responsibilities, focus four which includes fall protection, electrical, excavations (caught in between), and struck by hazards, scaffolds, steel erection, NFPA 70 e Arc Flash, cranes & hoists, material handling, fire protection, confined space work, stairways & ladders, PPE, and legal liabilities for supervisors & companies, and more.
